"Concentric Circles of Ministry."

Greetings Colfax Center Members and Attenders,

We have officially entered 2021! We made it through the holidays, the winter storms, the pandemic cancellations and even the Annual Congregational Meeting (Praise the Lord!). It was so much fun to see so many of you this past Sunday for worship and I look forward to seeing so many more as the weather continues to warm. It's hard to believe that as I write this, Easter is just six short weeks away and we eagerly anticipate the buds on the trees, the birds singing, the spring storms rolling in and celebrating Christ's resurrection.

I love the Spring season. Not only does it completely transform the landscape, but it's a signal of new life from the cold and new opportunities for the year. As I think about what this year has in store for our church, especially as we celebrate 150 years of ministry and look to the future, it reminded me of Jesus' final words to his disciples in the book of Acts.

Just before he ascends into heaven he tells them, "you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." (Acts 1:8) Jesus calls his disciples to be witnesses to the message of the gospel in a progressively wider spanning ministry from local, to regional, to national, and eventually global; "Concentric Circles of Ministry."

As I was considering all of this a popular new song by *The Casting Crowns* called "Start Right Here" came on the radio. Its message to Christians is that they can fall prey to mindset that the "mission" and the "ministry" of the church is only "out there," far away in the unreached nations and cultures of the world. But Jesus is clear, our mission and our ministry is not just far away, it starts right here, where we live, eat, work and breathe. As the gospel transforms us as individuals and families, we in turn seek to see our neighborhoods, communities, towns and regions transformed as well. Consider some of the lyrics:

"We got a Rockstar preacher, Who won't wake us from our dreams. We want our blessings in our pocket, We keep our missions overseas. But for the hurting in our cities, Would we even cross the street?

I'm like the brother of the prodigal, Who turned his nose and puffed his chest. He didn't run off like his brother, But his soul was just as dead. What if the church on Sunday, Was still the church on Monday too? What if we came down from our towers, And walked a mile in someone's shoes?

'cause we wanna see the heart set free and the tyrants kneel,
The walls fall down and our land he healed
But church if we want to see a change in the world out there
It's got to start right here; It's got to start right now
Lord, I'm starting right here; Lord, I'm starting right now...

In light of that, I would challenge all of us. As we embrace the Spring season, as people begin to open their doors again and enjoy the sunshine; as we begin to see some relief from the Covid Pandemic and start to gather together again; this is our opportunity as a church to minister to those in our midst. We are called to be Jesus' witnesses, both with our words, and with our lives. Let us begin with prayer, for our own transformation, and for the transformation of our families, our neighborhoods, our towns and our communities. Let us "start right here," and see the ministry and mission of Colfax Church work it's way out "to Jerusalem, to Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

#### Mission Team Update




