Dear Colfax Members and Attenders,

It is with a heart full of both gratitude and sadness, I write to share that I have accepted the call to serve as the next Senior Pastor of Rocky Mountain Community Church in Billings, Montana. After much prayer, reflection, and counsel, I believe this is the direction the Lord is leading me and my family, and I trust wholly in His timing and sovereign plan—not only for us, but for Colfax Church as well.

Serving as your pastor has been one of the great privileges of my life. You have welcomed me and my family into your lives, extended deep grace, and walked with me through seasons of ministry, challenge, fruitfulness and growth. I will continue to pray for you as you discern what God has next. Know that you are deeply loved—not only by me and my family, but far more by the Good Shepherd who never leaves or forsakes His flock. The Colfax Session will be in touch in the coming weeks regarding a congregational meeting to formally approve this transition as well as the timeline for the coming months. In the mean time I will continue to preach and lead at Colfax as God has called me until that transition takes place.


